Redevelopment Program

- York Region: 2-3 acre parcel with approx. 200 affordable apartment housing rental units for seniors
- UHS: 1 to 2 acre parcel for a future expansion
- Minto: the residual lands will be redeveloped for residential uses

CONCEPT DESIGN PRINCIPLES

Conceive the site plan in an open and transparent process.







Collaborate with the The Region, UHS, and Wyndam Gardens and surrounding community to create a unified neighbourhood plan.



Create a neighbourhood of walkable streetscapes, mews, and parks (quality public realm).









Information Session 1

Transition the massing of buildings over the site to relate in scale to the surrounding context.



Seek to provide a shared community venue to replace the existing community centre, a central place for the larger community.





CONCEPT DESIGN PRINCIPLES


Provide a neighbourhood scaled park that serves to unify the different communities on the site.



Craft the style or language of the building designs to compliment the existing context.



Provide a rich and varied residential program to accommodate a broad market segment.
